



MILLER FINE ARTS MAGNET MIDDLE SCHOOL 2019-2020 DRESS CODE

STUDENTS MAY WEAR THE FOLLOWING:

PANTS OR SKIRTS:

- **Plain khaki, black or navy pants, or plain khaki, black or navy skirts**
- **Jeans, and cargo pants are NOT allowed.** However, jeans are permitted on days designated by the principal.
- Shorts no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee may be worn during the summer and spring months (Aug., Sept., April, May). Shorts must be in dress code colors.
- Pants must be of appropriate size, not flare legged, worn as designed and of ankle length. Pants designed to be worn below the top of the hip bone are not allowed.
- If pants have belt loops, a belt **MUST** be worn.
- Pants **MUST NOT** be tucked into shoes or socks.
- Skirts must be no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee.
- Skirts cannot have any slits or openings.

SHIRTS:

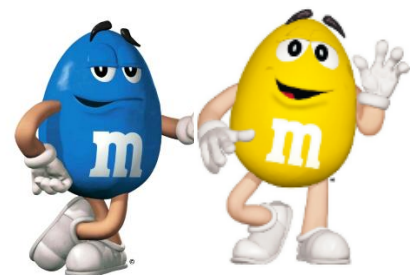
- **Plain white, blue (navy or royal), black or yellow polo shirts ONLY**
- Polo shirts can be long sleeve or short sleeve.
- Polo shirts must have a collar.
- School t-shirts, sweatshirts or sweaters, or plain white, blue (**navy or royal**) or yellow color sweatshirts and sweaters may be worn.
- All shirts must be of appropriate size.
- Plain white undershirts or turtlenecks may be worn underneath polo shirts, school t-shirts, sweatshirts and sweaters.

JACKETS:

- **Plain white, blue (navy or royal), black or yellow polo jackets ONLY**
- No oversized coats may be worn in the school building.
- **JACKETS WITH HOODS OR HOODIES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE WORN IN THE SCHOOL.**

SHOES AND SOCKS:

- **TENNIS SHOES CAN BE WORN WITH SHOE LACES THAT ARE THE APPROPRIATE SIZE FOR THE SHOE ONLY.**
- All shoes must have closed toes and heels.
- Soft-soled shoes may be worn. (No heels allowed).
- Plain white or black socks are to be worn with the tennis shoes.

BELTS:

- **Black or brown belts only can be worn**

JEWELRY:

- Gold or Silver Jewelry
- Dog tags are not allowed
- Pendants and earrings larger than a quarter and multiple bracelets are not allowed

HAIR:

Each student's hair must be neat, clean and well groomed. Dyed hair that is not a natural color or shade is not allowed with the exception for days when spirit day activities are scheduled by the school. "Unnatural" hair color includes, but is not limited to, hair that is dyed pink, purple, bright-red, yellow, blue or green. In addition, *any hair style and or hair accessories that could cause a disruption to the school setting may be prohibited at the Principal's discretion.*

Any item prohibited in the Bibb County Board of Education Guidelines for Success or Dress Code is not allowed. *All items, which in the judgment of the principal (designee), disrupt or distract from the teaching and learning process will not be allowed.*
